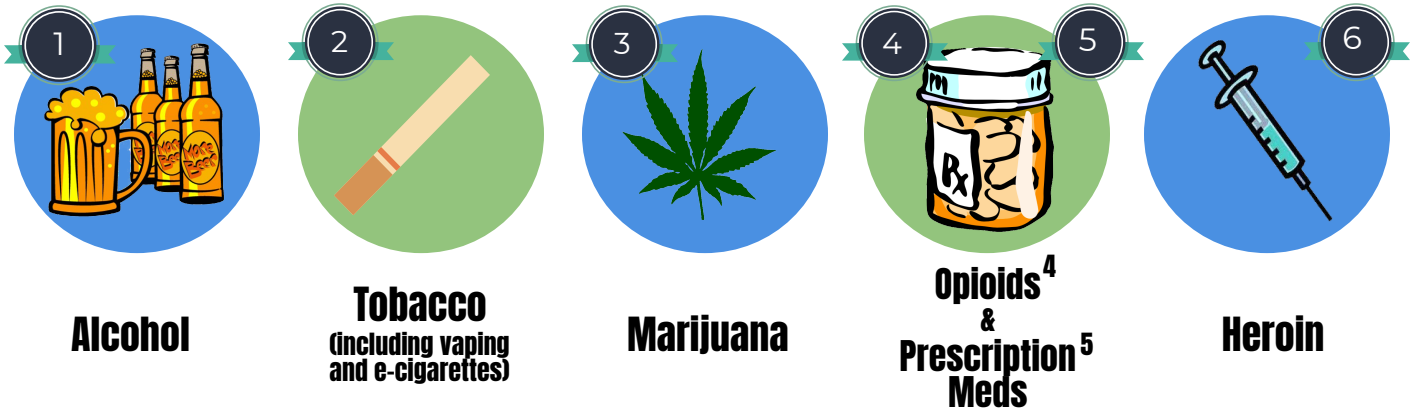

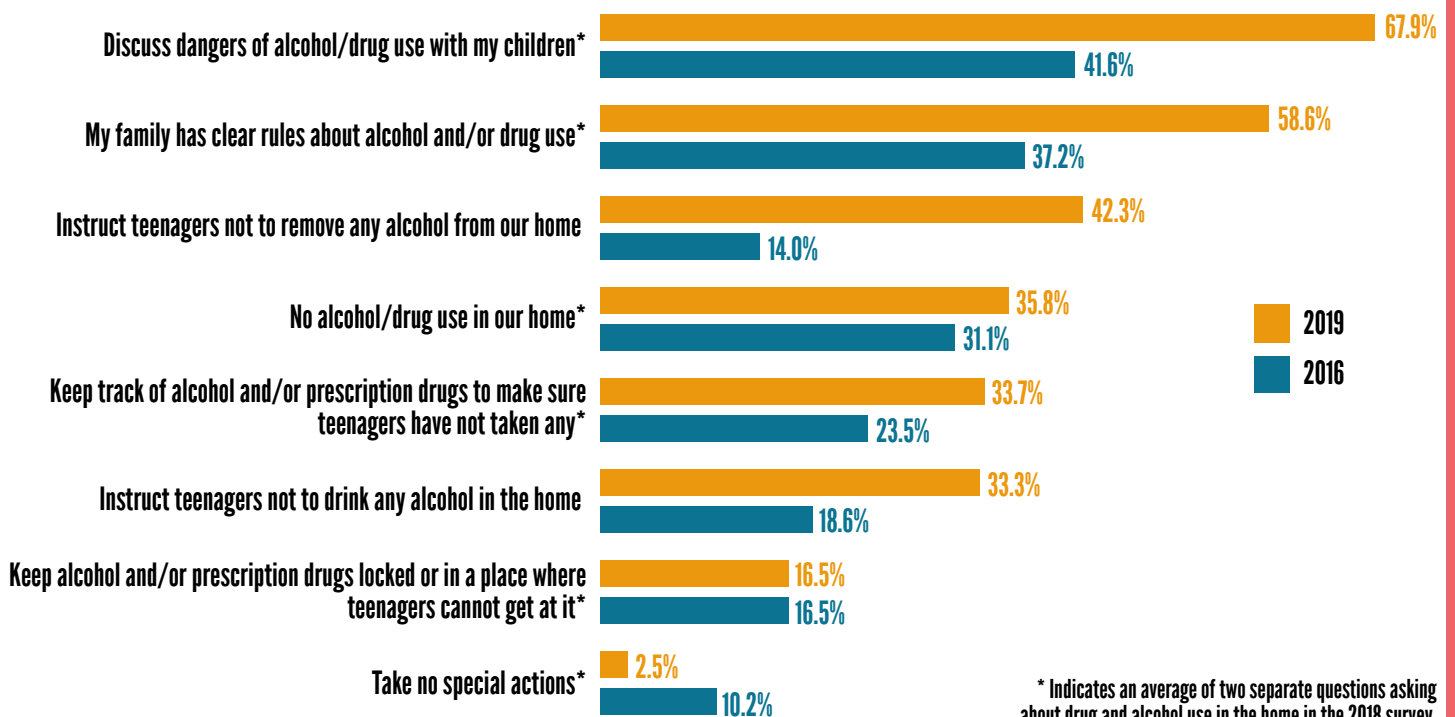
## Drugs of Choice

## Alcohol and Drug Safety

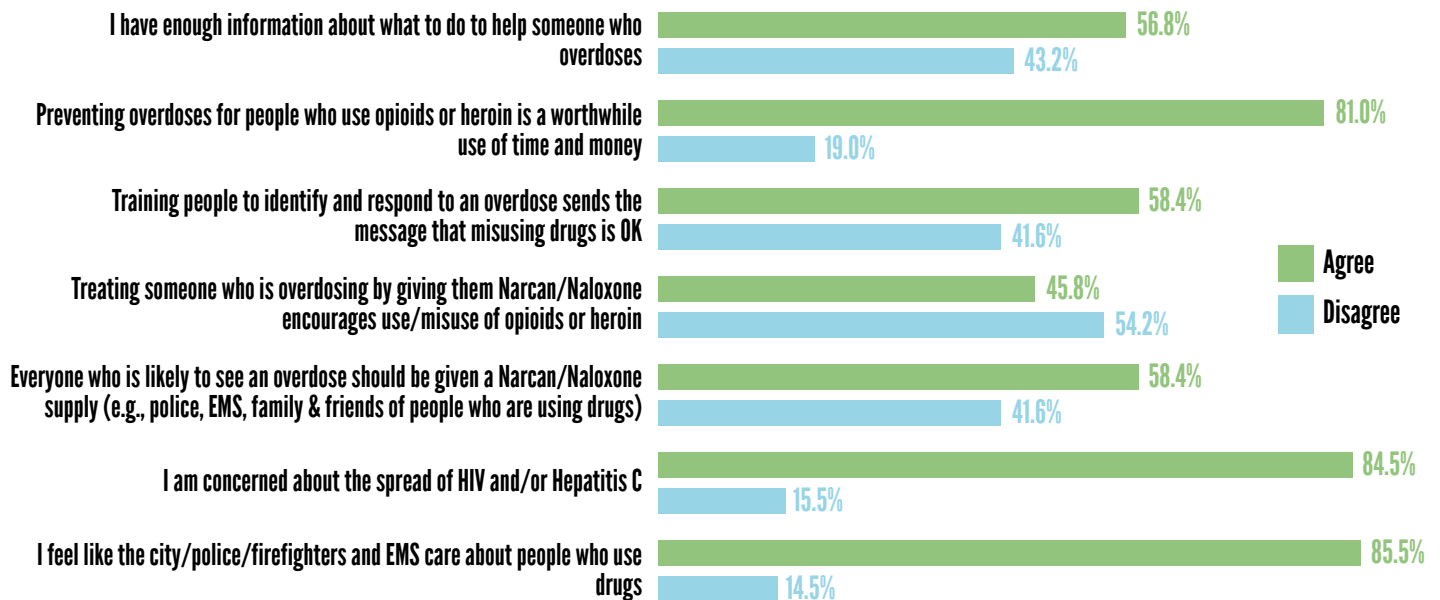

\* Indicates an average of two separate questions asking about drug and alcohol use in the home in the 2018 survey.

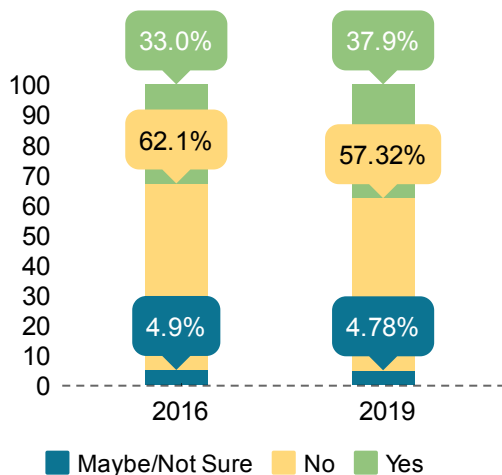
# Response to Overdoses in the Community

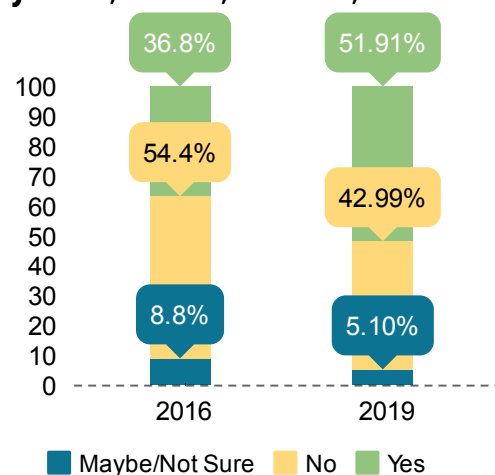


# Heroin and Prescription Drug Abuse

## Strategies for reducing the heroin/opioid problem in your community:

### Most Effective:

1. Drug treatment and rehabilitation services (e.g., rehab, peer support groups, etc.)
2. Prevention activities (e.g., educational programs, community events, mentoring)
3. Awareness raising activities
4. Reform pain medication prescribing practices.

### Least Effective:

1. Needle exchange programs
2. Respond to overdose with Narcan (Naloxone)



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
