

Indiana Project LAUNCH Incredible Years Study

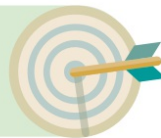
One Community One Family offers two completely free services, home coaching and parent groups, for three programs (Parents & Babies Program, Parents & Toddler Program, and Parents & Preschool Program).

Parent Coaches are dedicated to linking families to needed resources as well as offering free group workshops to all caregivers with children, ages 0 to 6. Home coaching is available for families with transportation difficulties.



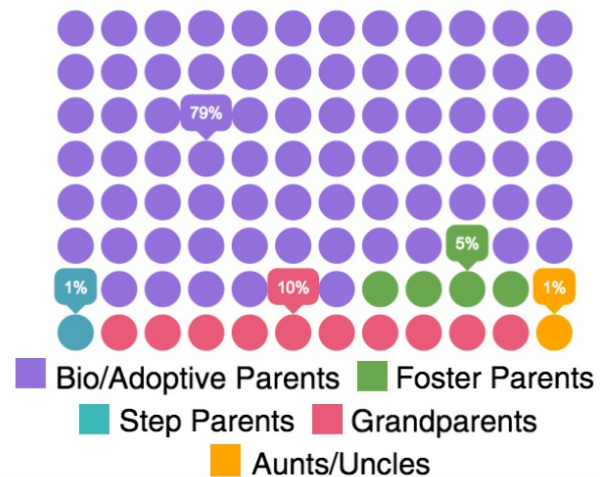
Participating Families

Group Participation

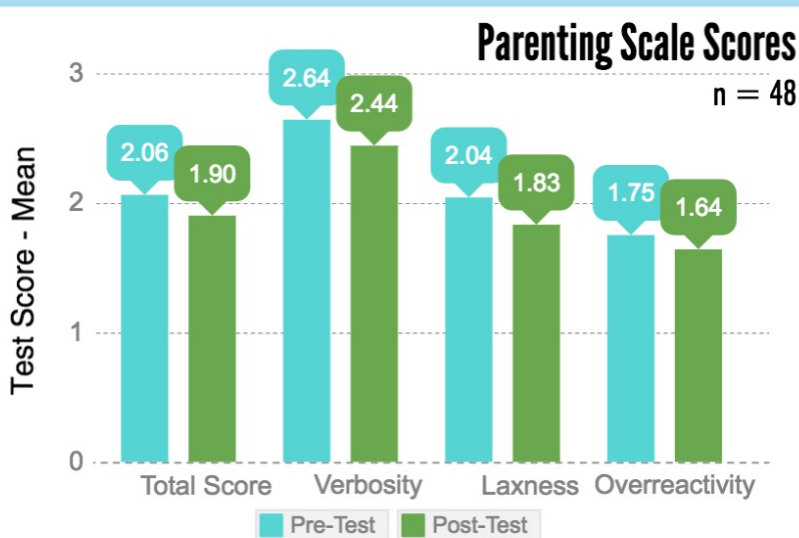


71% completed the program

Caregivers take tests measuring their parenting skills before and after participating in the program. Lower scores are better, indicating improvement in parenting.

100% of families would **RECOMMEND** the program to others

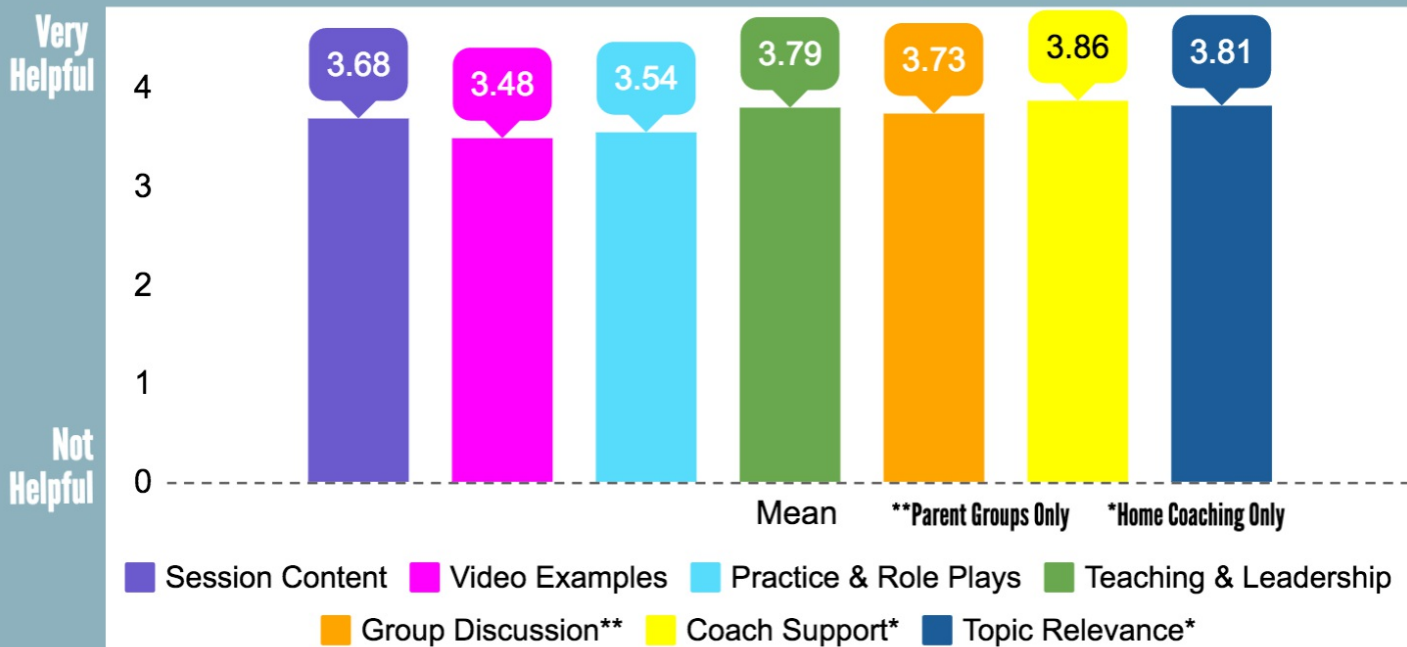
96% of families felt that the approach used to enhance their child's development or behavior was **APPROPRIATE**
