- Call, Text, or Chat Online 988
 - Suicide & Crisis Lifeline 24/7 Service
 - Available to anyone in a suicidal or emotional crisis
 - OR call 911
 - 988 routes callers to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline
 - Press 1 for Veterans Crisis Line (for military service members, veterans, and family
 - Or **text 838255** to 988
 - Press 2 for suicide support en Español
 - Press 3 for suicide support for youth and adults in the LGBTQ+ community
 - For deaf or hard of hearing ASL users, call 988 over Videophone
 - For TTY Users: Use your preferred relay service or dial 711 then 988.
