



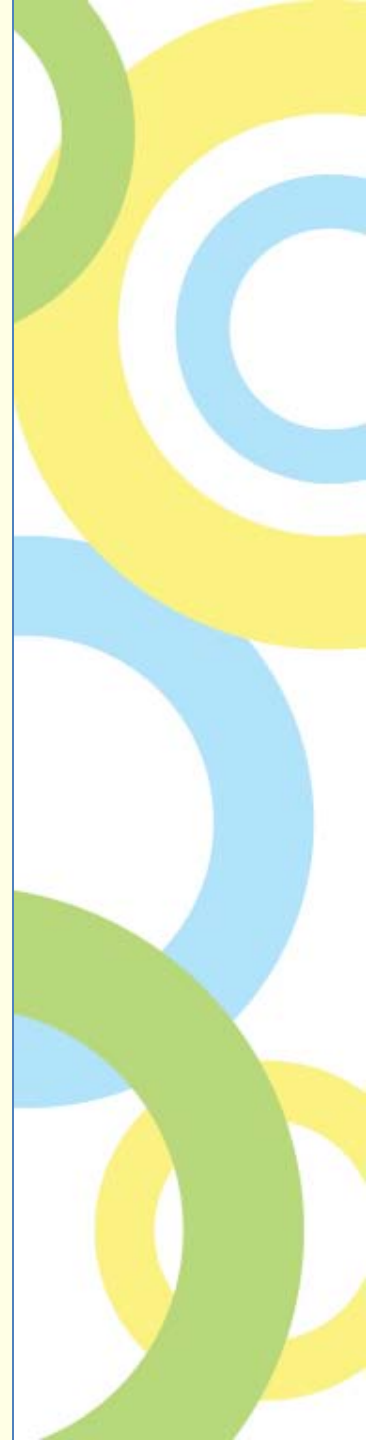

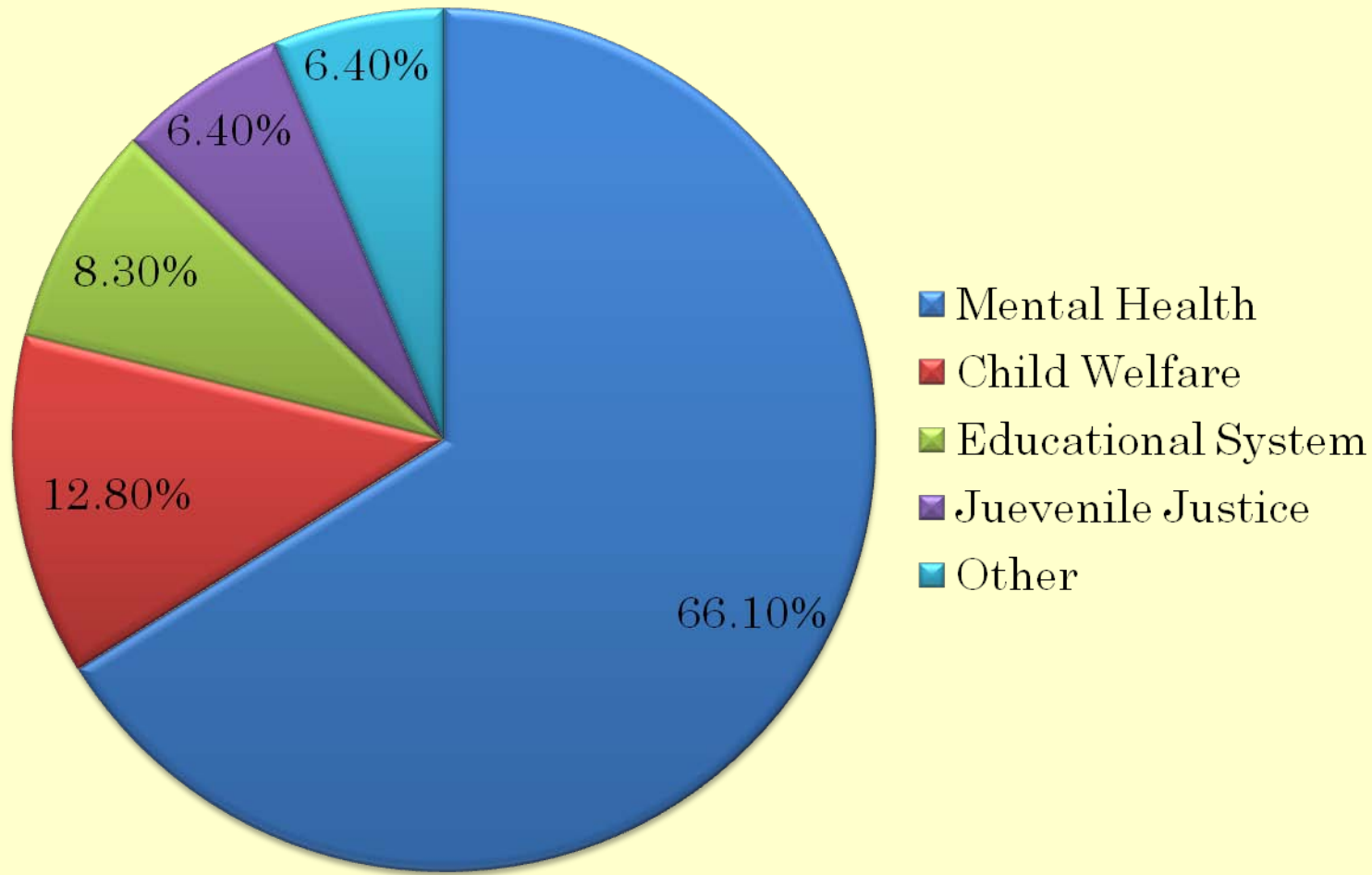
## Demographics of Youth involved in One Community One Family

## Referral Source

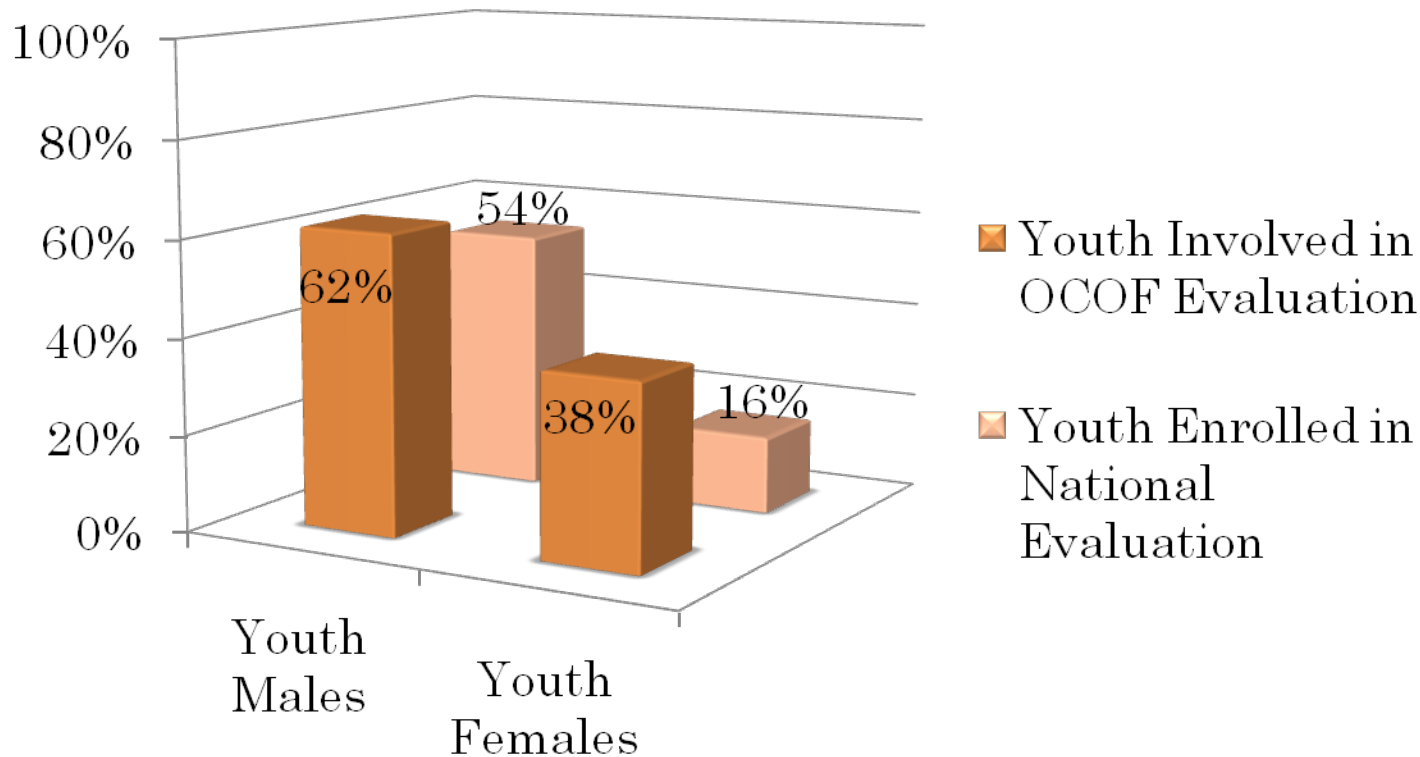


# Most Common Presenting Problems at Time of Enrollment

Attention Problems	27.5%
Behavior Related Challenges	12.8%
Early Childhood Difficulties, RAD	12.8%
Post-Traumatic Stress Related Challenges	10.15
Bipolar Related Challenges	7.3%
Depression Related Challenges	6.4%
Other Issues	16.5%

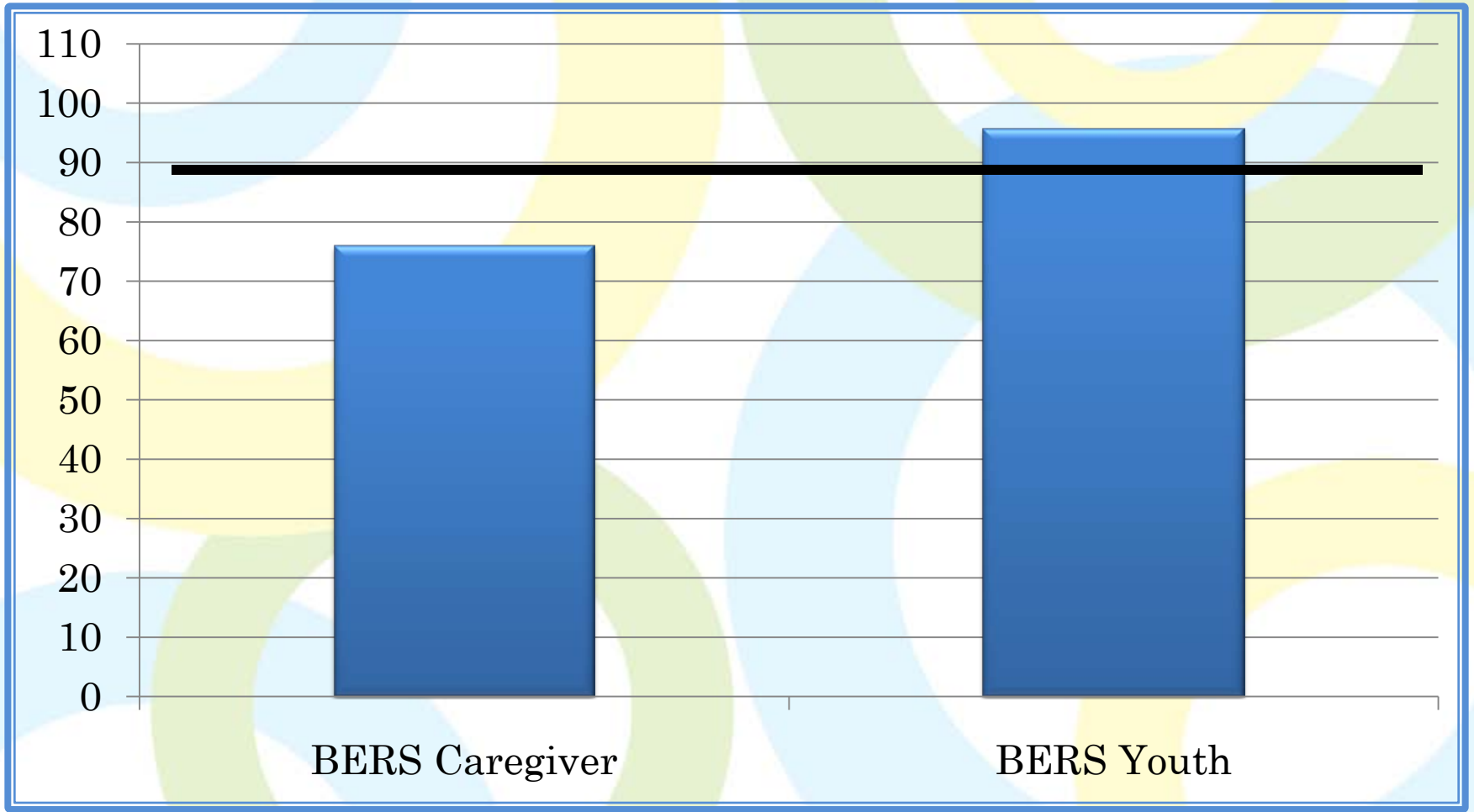

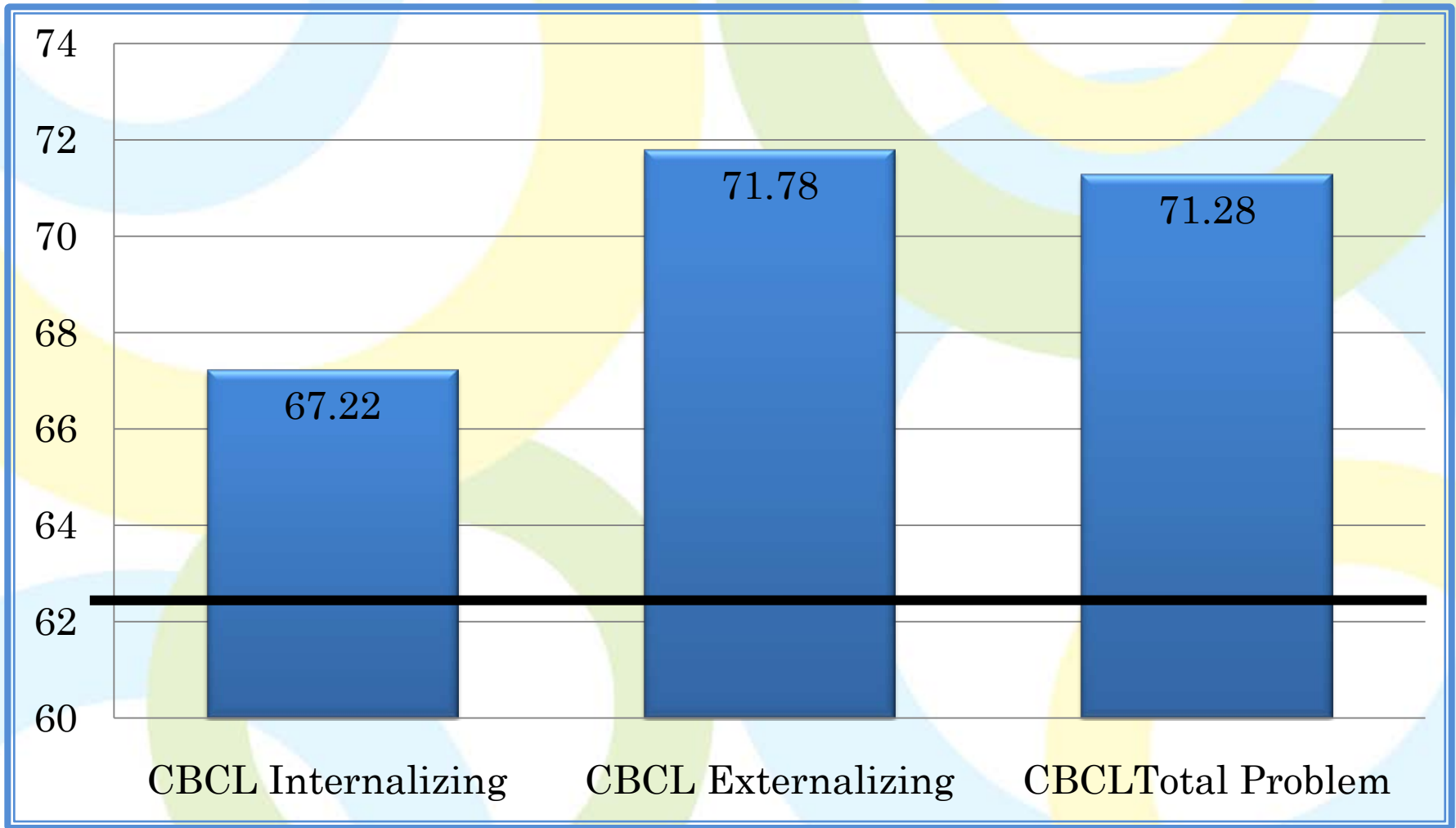
# Average Strengths Ratings at Enrollment



Behavioral and Emotional Rating Scale

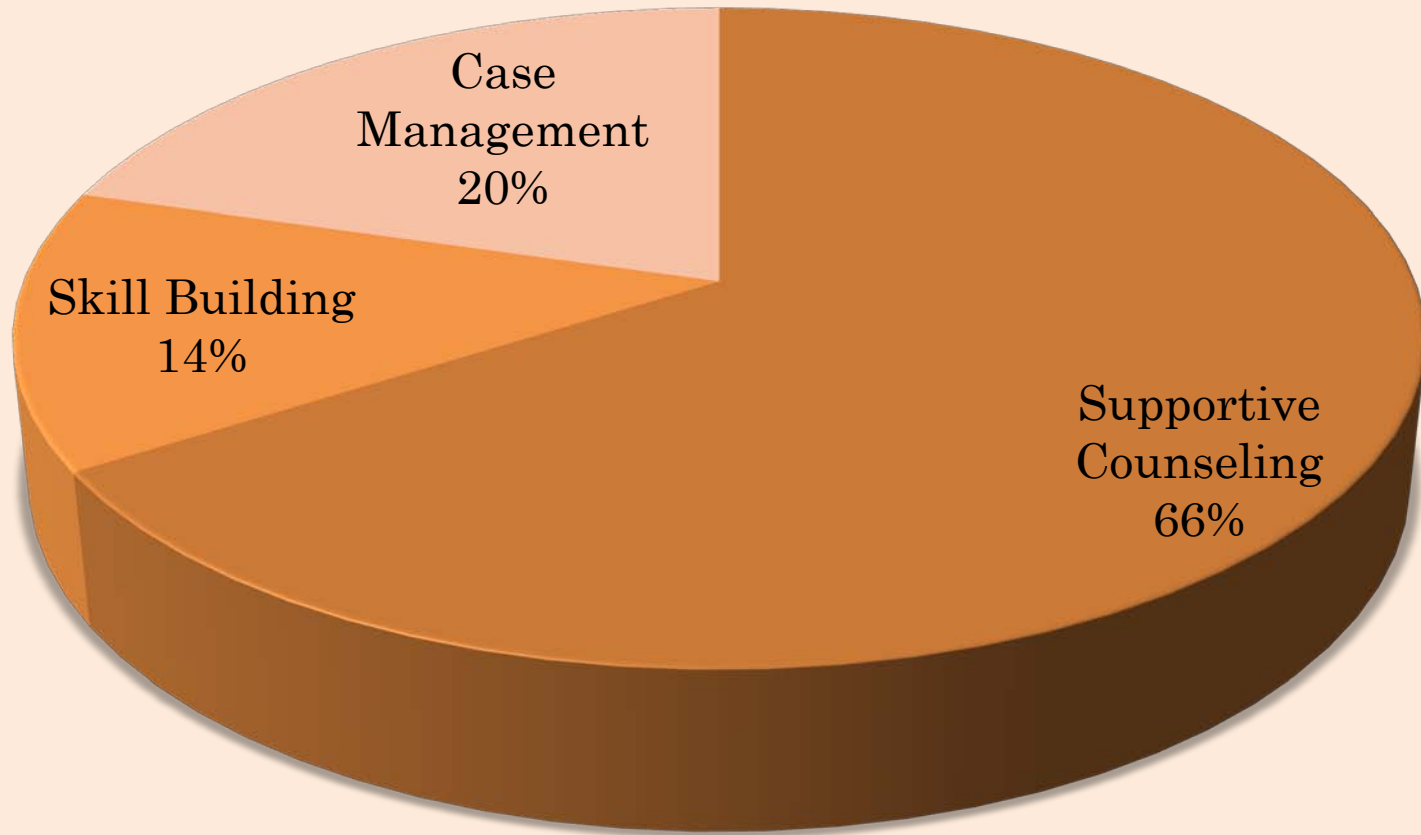


# Average CBCL Scores at Enrollment

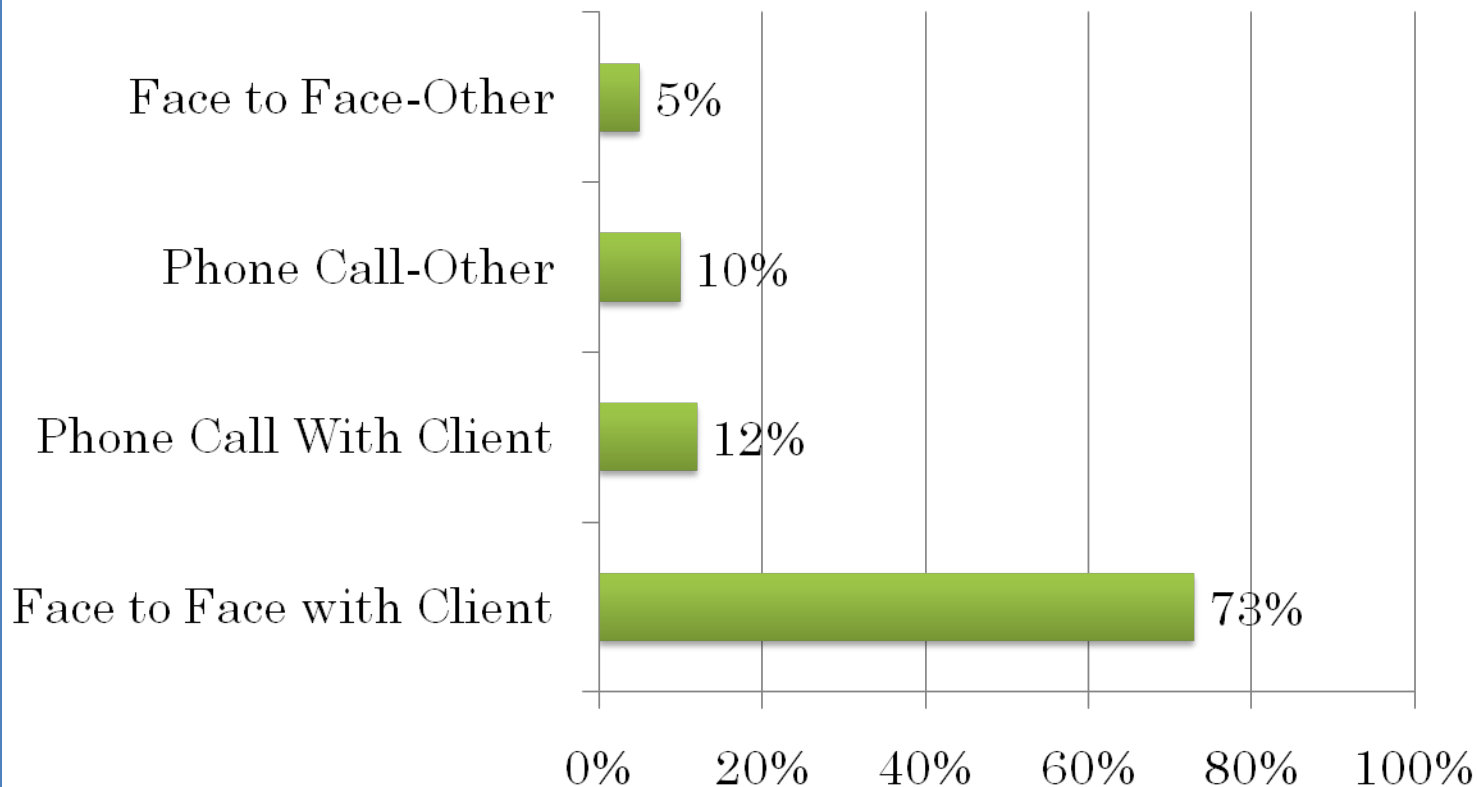

# Types of Peer Support Services with United Families



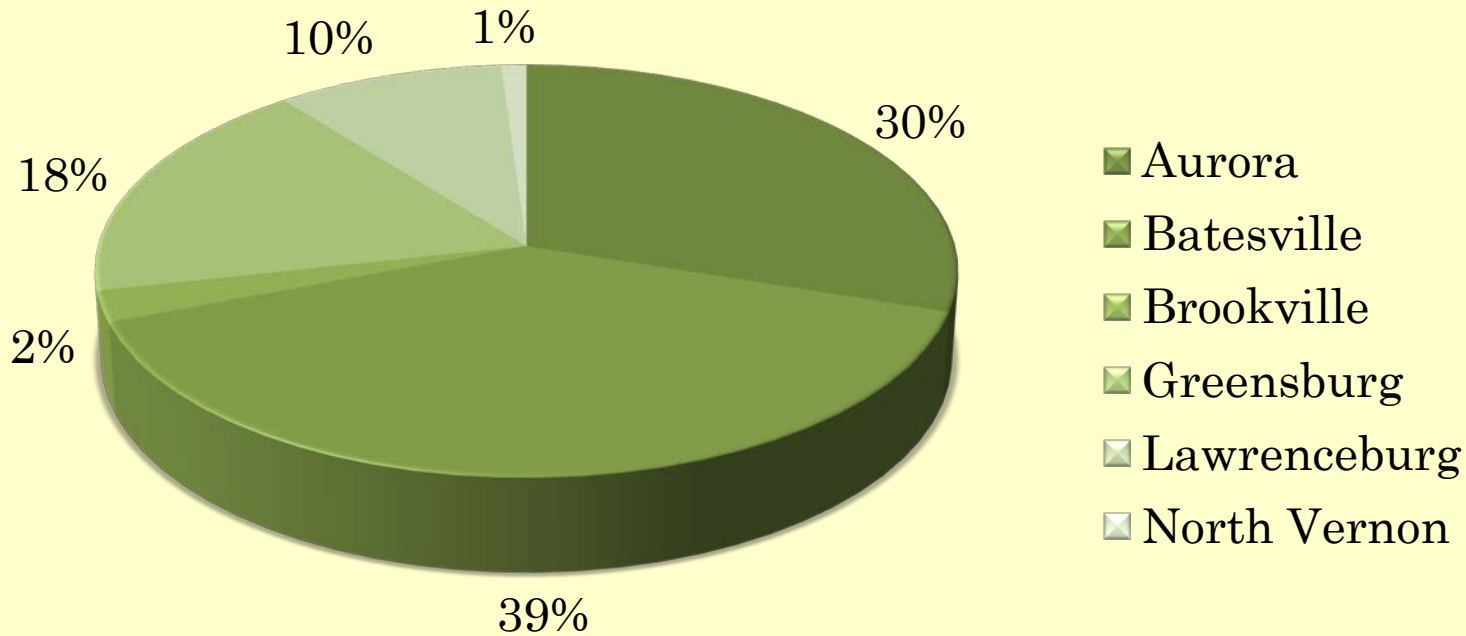
## Type of Peer Support Contact With United Families
