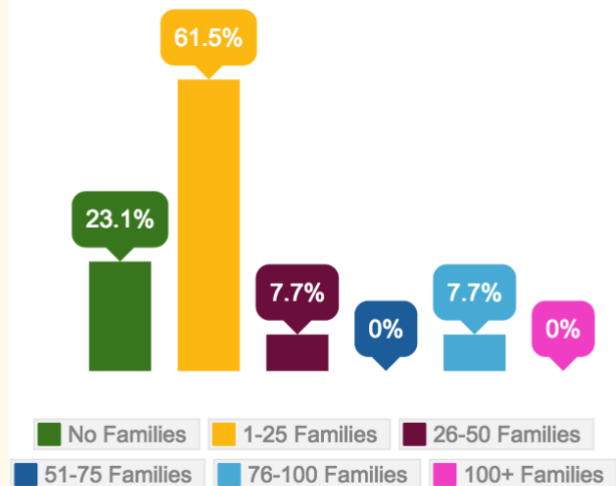

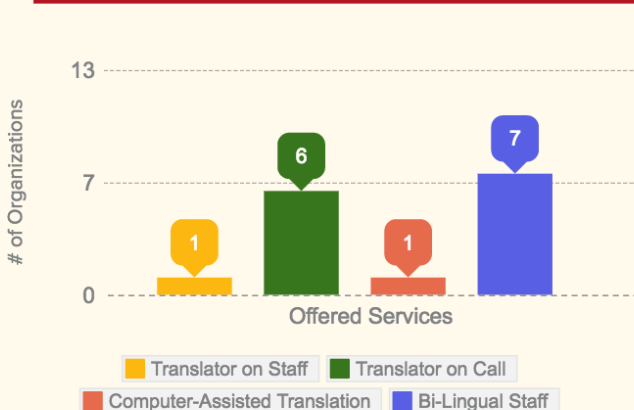
Hispanic child populations (ages 0-8) across the region are quite small, ranging from 0.6% to 5.4%. However, this population is growing.

## Spanish-speaking Families Served

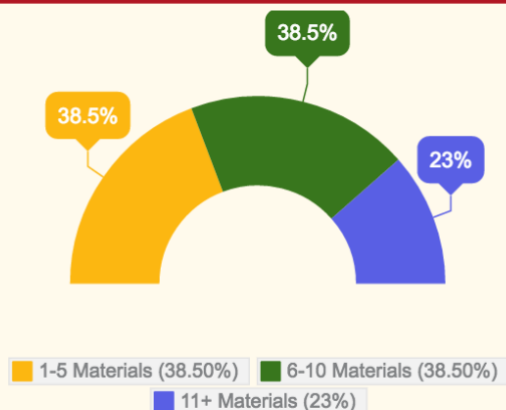


Almost 85% of organizations served less than 25 families each year.
